

BUICK MAKES FIRST SUPERBOWL APPEARANCE

Buick aficionados may have perked up during this year's Superbowl commercial programming. For the first time ever, Buick aired a Superbowl ad. The ad features the new Buick Cascada convertible, which is the first drop-top model in over 20 years.

It was reported by Business Insider that Buick's sales expanded by 6% last year, a whopping increase of 1.2 million units. This of course was inline with what has been called a banner year for the automotive industry.

The ad itself is a part of Buick's "That's not a Buick" U.S. ad campaign which launched in 2014. The ad features New York Giant's Odell Beckham Jr and actor and swimsuit model Emily Ratajkowski. The play a newly married couple who shock their wedding guests when they report that their stylish get-a-way car is in fact a Buick.

The Associated Press reported that the 2014 ad campaign is portraying cars and SUVs as sporty luxury vehicles preferred by younger people.

According to General Motors, it's starting to work:

The average age of a Buick buyer was 66.2 in 2000, but that fell to around 58 last year, the company reports.

Designed by GM's German arm, the Cascada has




already been sold in Europe under the name Opel. The US model will feature a 1.6I-liter turbocharged four-cylinder, rated at 200 horsepower.

MARIA'S CORN PUDDING

4 Cups Frozen Corn (I don't bother with defrosting the corn because it

4 T All Purpose Flour

2 t Baking Powder

goes in the blender)

6 T Unsalted 6 T Sugar Butter (softened)

1 t Salt

1-1/2 Cups Heavy Cream 5 large eggs

Combine in a blender (if you don't have a high powered blender like a Vitamix, blend in two batches)

NOTE: This is the key to a good corn pudding.

Pour in a pan greased with Pam. I usually use an aluminum square deep dish pan.

350 Oven (or 325 for convection bake which is what I use)

Cook for 45 min to an hour. Check with toothpick. It is done when it comes out clean.


